




## Improved ISIP Tier 1 Results Grade K-2



## Rutherford ES | Grade 3 Math STAAR Scores Meets & Masters Grade Level




## Floyd ES • Grade 5 Reading STAAR Scores Growth in Achievement




■ 2018 BEFORE COACHING






